Ocean and Climate Youth Ambassador Programme

September 21– October 16 2017 onboard Peace Boat's 95th Global Voyage

Project Description

Peace Boat's "Ocean and Climate Youth Ambassador Programme" will bring youth leaders from Small Island States on the front line of climate change and marine degradation to travel onboard Peace Boat's ship, engaging in capacity building and bringing their message to citizens and government representatives through the voyage. Peace Boat is seeking youth active in their communities on issues relating to ocean welfare and/or climate action, who can share their message through various means of expression. The youth will embark upon the 95th Voyage in Europe in September 2017. There, they will connect with civil society organizations and government agencies in ports visited, including Spain, France, the United Kingdom and Iceland. Their voyage will end as Peace Boat docks in New York in October 2017, where the youth ambassadors will report on their efforts to both the United Nations community and the broader public. This will be a highlight of the events held in New York for the 95th Voyage.

Volunteer Videographer position

Peace Boat is seeking a Volunteer Videographer who will work with Peace Boat to create a documentary and different videos about the Peace Boat Ocean and Climate Youth Ambassador Programme. The 20-minute documentary will be shown during COP 23 (6-17 November 2017) in Bonn, Germany and will be made available online for wide dissemination for awareness raising and education. A number of short videos will be shown in different awareness raising events in Lisbon, Bourdeaux, London, Edinburgh, Reykjavik and New York.

The Volunteer will work under the direction of Peace Boat, but will also coordinate with other members of the Communications Team regarding the details of the assignment. The Communications Team will give guidance on the video material to be produced.

Specific tasks

- Film and produce a documentary including cooperation on developing the script.
- Capture and produce short videos to show in events in countries visited during the programme.
- Develop media package containing both final, publishable content and raw materials for future use in Peace Boat video material.

Duration



- Four consecutive weeks between 21 September and 16 October 2017, from Barcelona to New York onboard Peace Boat.
- The Videographer Volunteer should also be available for preparation (via email and Skype) for preparation prior to the programme and must have time to keep working to edit the documentary to final format, to be premiered for the first time in mid-November.

Requirements for Applicants:

- Skilled in shooting videos and sound recording
- Experienced with video editing tools (including Final Cut or Adobe Premier Pro) including editing footage collected by others such participants
- Skilled in video post-production and work with video files in multiple format
- Familiar with issues relating to climate change, environmental protection and youth advocacy
- Fluency in English
- Good interpersonal skills and be able to work as part of a team under pressure
- Core competencies: communication, alliance-building, and drive for results
- Priority will be given to applicants from AOSIS countries

Remuneration and Expenses

This is a volunteer position with no remuneration. Peace Boat will cover some expenses.

Expenses covered by Peace Boat

- Flights to and from the volunteer's place of residence and Peace Boat's vessel
- Accommodation in shared cabins onboard the ship for the duration of the voyage
- Meals onboard the ship
- Port charges and tips
- Hotel in Barcelona and New York

Expenses covered by Volunteer

- Travel insurance for the duration that the participant is away from home
- Personal expenses while onboard including laundry and internet
- Personal expenses while in ports including meals

- A detailed and up-to-date professional resume
- A cover letter
- Work samples (a list of links to videos shot and produced by candidate available online)
